They found 38 settlers remaining at Jamestown. After forming a governing councilâ€”including Christopher Newport, commander of the sea voyage, and Captain John Smith , a former mercenary who had been accused of insubordination aboard ship by several other company membersâ€”the group searched for a suitable settlement site. The first brick church was started. They lived first across the river from Jamestown, and later at his Varina Farms plantation near Henricus. The Virginia Company was forced to yield its control to royal authority. The settlers were now protected against any attacks that might occur from the local Powhatan Indians, whose hunting land they were living on. Royal Colony[edit] Some historians have noted that, as the settlers of the Virginia Colony were allowed some representative government, and they prospered, King James I was reluctant to lose either power or future financial potential. The first appointed governor was Lord de la Warr, but he did not arrive in Virginia until Pace, after securing himself and his neighbors on the south side of the James River, took a canoe across river to warn Jamestown, which narrowly escaped destruction, although there was no time to warn the other settlements. The site was also not inhabited by the Native population. A period of relative peace followed the marriage in April of the colonist and tobacco planter John Rolfe to Pocahontas , a daughter of Chief Powhatan who had been captured by the settlers and converted to Christianity. Relations had already been mixed between the newcomers and the Powhatan Indians. The new palisade provided some security from attacks by the Virginia Indians for colonists farming and fishing lower on the Peninsula from that point. This charter allowed the Company to run lotteries to raise money. In October, while a prisoner, Opechancanough was killed by a soldier shot in the back assigned to guard him.
